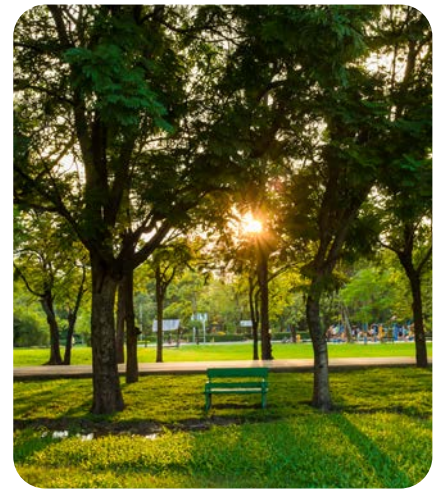
Parks & Outdoor Spaces



Despite its bustling urban environment, London is dotted with expansive parks and green spaces where locals and

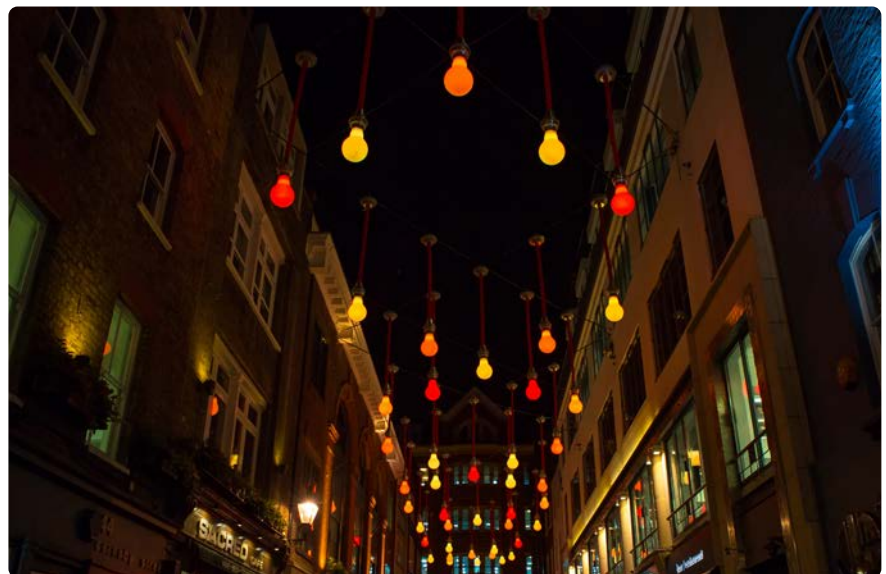
visitors alike can escape the city's hustle and bustle. From the majestic Royal Parks of Hyde Park and Regents Park to
